SMØLA - ATTRACTIONS/EXCURSIONS

Brattværet Fishing Village

Duration: 3 hrs

Visit the old, genuine fishing village of Brattværet, just a short zodiac ride from the ship's anchorage. Guided walk in the once a thriving fishing community with school, prayer house, wharfs and docks. Enjoy delicious Norwegian waffles and hear the history of Smøla, the fisheries and the Thule myth.

Tour de Veiholmen

Duration: 3,5 hrs Guided bus tour (30 min.) to the still active fishing community Veiholmen at the northernmost tip of Smøla, linked to the main island by a road that with its bridges, landfills and protective breakwaters is an adventure in itself. Guided walk in this small, but active and vibrant fishing community with local cafes and pubs, an exciting museum and coastal heritage idyll.

Hiking in Dyrnesdalen

Duration: 3 hrs Guided hike (2-3 hrs, very moderate-medium difficulty) in the flat landscape of Dyrnesdalen and towards the windmill farm of Smøla, once Europe's largest. Visit one of the highest peaks at Smøla (45 m), enjoy the fantastic landscape and maybe also the majestic sea eagle.

Sea Eagle Safari by boat

Smøla has one of the densest populations of sea eagles in the world. Guided safari starting with a scenic and comfortable boat ride to the prime location for sea eagles, far off the beaten track. A RIB boat will take you even further into the land of sea eagles, with very good chances of a wild life encounter. Highly recommended for photographers.

Cultural Smøla Duration: 3 hrs

Short, guided bus ride to the beautifully located old church of western Smøla. Short and easy walk to enjoy the views from the nearby hillside before visiting the church and learn about its dramatic history. An intimate and special concert will be held for you, with local artists performing local music.

Deep sea fishing

Board a traditional fishing boat and head out for a few hours of angling with guide. Halibut, haddock, mackerel, plaice, tusk and cod are most likely to be hooked.

HITRA - ATTRACTIONS/EXCURSIONS

*Group excursions with guide (also possible when calling Kristiansund, duration 8,5 hrs)

The Norwegian Salmon Island

Duration: 2-4,5 hrs (10-36 pax) Learn the story of the fish farming industry through an educational exhibition and an exciting visit to a salmon farm, where you also can take part in hand feeding of the fish. Optional: Salmon lunch and local beer at Terningen lighthouse (est. 1833) and/or visit a brand-new fish processing plant, the most modern of its kind in the world.

Back to the Iron Age at Dolmsundet*

Duration: 3,5 hrs (10-45 pax) Bus excursion (30 min. drive) to idyllic Dolmsundet with a reconstructed Iron Age longhouse. Enjoy a cup of mead and the magical atmosphere around the camp fire, just like the Vikings did... Visit the nearby Dolm medieval church and admire the stunning views from the Dolmsund bridge.

Visit a Deer Farm*

Duration: 2-3 hrs (10-45 pax) Hitra is renowned for its large and dense population of red deer. The farm DalPro (20 min. drive) is engaged in deer and wild sheep farming and has been awarded for its locally produced cured leg of mutton. Visit this farm and take part in hand feeding of the deer. Optional: Outdoor lunch based on local produce.

Hopsjø - old trading centre by the coast*

Duration: 3,5-4,5 hrs (10-90 pax) Bus excursion (35 min. drive) to the old trading centre (est. 1730) with so many interesting stories to tell! Visit the old general store with a great collection of ancient artefacts, see the whaling exhibition in the old warehouse, join a short trip on an old, restored boat, once used for herring fishing. Optional: Locally produced lunch in the old warehouse restaurant.

Hiking at Ulvøya - at the ocean's edge*

Duration: 4 hrs (10-45 pax) Ulvøystien hiking trail, 35 min. drive from the harbour, offers a magnificent view. Hike along the ocean on the bare rock-face, stony beaches and ravines, well secured in exposed places, and follow the coastal moor back (about 2,5 hrs round trip). Stop along the way to enjoy a Norwegian packed lunch with sandwich, drinks and fruit.

The Coastal Museum

Duration: 2 hrs (10-90 pax) Can also be combined with the above excursions. The museum displays an interesting exhibition portraying a typical 1920 family. Hear the story of the people and learn about the transition from the old coastal culture to the modern era.
