

# Rates, Terms, and Conditions 2026

## Port of Kristiansund and Nordmøre IMC

- Cruise port of **Kristiansund N**
- Cruise destination **Smøla island** (tender port)



### GENERAL INFORMATION

This is a translated excerpt of the official document “KRISTIANSUND OG NORDMØRE HAVN IKS, HAVNEREGULATIV 2026, VILKÅR OG PRISER,” which is in Norwegian. In case of any disputes, the Norwegian version will prevail. The excerpt includes costs most relevant for cruise ships. For tender calls to Smøla island applies fairway dues, ISPS security fee per passenger (minimum fee) and cruise passenger fee.

All rates are in Norwegian kroner (NOK) and exclude value-added tax (VAT).

### FAIRWAY DUES

#### Regulation on fairway dues

All vessels calling a port within the inter-municipal area of the Port of Kristiansund and Nordmøre IMC must pay fairway dues to support the harbour’s operational costs related to public safety and accessibility.

Fairway dues are charged per call. In case of multiple calls during the same day from 00:00 to 24:00, the fee is imposed only once.

### QUAY FEE

Calculated based on the vessel’s gross tonnage (BT), the quay fee covers the vessel’s use of port and mooring facilities. The minimum fee applies to each unique vessel. If a vessel remains docked beyond 24 hours and changes berth within the port, the fee recalculates based on half or full-day rates. 6 hours or less will be counted as half a day.

#### QUAY FEE (excluding ISPS security fee)

**Minimum fee:** NOK 292 per day.

### ISPS SECURITY FEE

For ships calling at ISPS-approved port facilities, a security fee is imposed in addition to the quay fee. The security fee is the vessel's payment to cover the costs of investments and operation of security measures.

<b>ISPS security fee</b>	30 % of quay fee

If the port provides ISPS security guards, a mandatory security fee is charged per passenger. The security fee shall cover the port's costs for the required security of passenger traffic in the port.

Type	Rate	Unit
Security fee for vessels in international traffic, when using ISPS security guards	NOK 16,50	per passenger
Minimum fee	NOK 13 500	per call

## PASSENGER FEE

The passenger fee applies to both boarding and disembarking passengers, and passengers in transit. The fee covers local arrangements for the passenger, including costs associated with bus handling.

The passenger fee is waived if the authorities deny permission to land.

## OTHER SERVICES AND DISCOUNTS

### MOORING ASSISTANCE

Mooring/unmooring within regular hours (Mon–Fri 8 am–4 pm)	NOK 1 250	per man
Mooring/unmooring outside regular hours (Mon–Fri 4 pm–8 am + weekends and public holidays)	NOK 2 100	per man

### RENTAL OF EQUIPMENT

Type	Rate	Unit
Yokohama-fender, 2.0 x 3.5 m (2 units available)	NOK 1 500	per unit per 24 hours
Gangway, 12 m	NOK 1 500	per 24 hours

For assistance with installation of Yokohama-fenders, an hourly rate for use of the harbour boat will apply.

### DISCOUNTS (LNG AND ESI)

- LNG discount**  
 Vessels using LNG may apply for a 20% quay fee discount. Subject to approval.
- Environmental discount (ESI)**  
 Vessels with an ESI score of 50+ qualify for a fairway due discount (30%). For cruise vessels, an additional quay fee discount based on ESI score applies:

ESI score	Discount
25–49	5 %
50–74	10 %
75–100	15 %
